A schema of nine stages:

- 1. My body and my self-image are who I am.
- 2. My external behavior is who I am.
- 3. My thoughts and feelings are who I am.
- 4. My deeper intuitions and felt knowledge in my body are who I am.
- 5. My shadow self is who I am.
- 6. I am empty and powerless.
- 7. I am much more than who I thought I was.
- 8. I and the Father are one. (John 10:30)
- 9. I am who I am.

Five ways of deeper understanding

- 1. Contemplative practice
- 2. Sabbath
- 3. Service
- 4. Shadow work
- 5. Spiritual direction
